

Information about the processing of personal data by Abraham Legal, advokátní kancelář s.r.o.

In connection with the processing of your personal data, in accordance with Article 13, paragraphs 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC („GDPR“), we inform you about the processing of your personal data by Abraham Legal, advokátní kancelář s.r.o. as follows:

1.1 Personal Data Controller:

Abraham Legal, advokátní kancelář s.r.o., with registered office at Pernerova 676/51, Karlín, 186 00 Prague 8, ID: 01437488, Tax ID: CZ01437488, registered in the Commercial Register maintained by the Municipal Court in Prague in Section C, Insert No. 205549 („Controller“)

1.2 Legal basis for processing:

- (a) Conclusion and performance of a contract or the performance of other measures at your request prior to the conclusion of a contract between you as the data subject and the Controller (legal basis: Article 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of the GDPR);
- (b) Evidence of representation of the data subject in whose interest the contract with the Controller is concluded and communication with any intermediary, agent or contact person in a similar capacity (legal basis: Article 6, paragraph 1, letters b) and f) of the GDPR);
- (c) Compliance with the Controller's tax, accounting and other legal obligations, including the issuing and storage of invoices (legal basis: Article 6, paragraph 1, letter c) of the GDPR);
- (d) Protecting the rights and legitimate interests of the Controller, in particular defending the Controller's claims and rights, as well as defending against claims brought by you as a data subject and by third parties (legal basis: Article 6, paragraph 1, letter f) of the GDPR);
- (e) Sending marketing content messages, in particular product offers or services of the Controller

or evaluation of services already provided (legal basis: Article 6, paragraph 1, letter f) of the GDPR);

- (f) Expressed in individual consents to the processing of personal data, if you have given such consent as a data subject (legal basis: Article 6, paragraph 1, letter a) of the GDPR);

1.3 Purpose of processing:

Provision of legal services

1.4 Recipients of personal data:

- (a) Public authorities (e. g. courts, administrative authorities);
- (b) Entities acting on behalf of the Controller, e. g. providers of accounting, marketing and information system maintenance services and technology;
- (c) Other recipients according to the needs and instructions of the client;

1.5 Period of processing of personal data:

- (a) Always for at least the duration of the contract;
- (b) For tax and accounting purposes for a period of 10 years from the end of the calendar year in which the period for the assessment of tax has expired;
- (c) For the purposes of protecting the rights and legitimate interests of the Controller, in particular the assertion of claims or the defence of claims for a period of 3 years from the end of the cooperation or performance of the contract and, in the case of pending proceedings, until final termination and until the claims are time-barred.

After the expiry of the processing

period, the personal data will be handled in accordance with the applicable legislation, in particular the Advocacy Act, Act No. 499/2004 Coll., on archiving and file service and the GDPR.

1.6 Legal consequences of failure to provide data:

The provision of personal data is voluntary. However, if you do not provide the Controller with the necessary personal data, the Controller will not be able to provide the requested action, conclude a contract with you, provide services, send you the requested business information or otherwise communicate with you.

Providing the data necessary for the issue of an invoice is a legal obligation and results from the Value Added Tax Act.

If you are an intermediary, agent or contact person acting on behalf of or in the interest of a data subject with whom the Controller enters into a contract, the provision of your personal data is voluntary but necessary for the conclusion and performance of the contract between the Controller and the data subject you represent or in whose interest you otherwise act.

The provision of personal data on the basis of consent to the processing of personal data is always voluntary and failure to provide it (failure to give consent or withdrawal of consent) has no sanctionable consequences.

1.7 Rights of the client:

In connection with the processing of personal data, you have the right to:

- (a) Access to your personal data, i.e. the right to obtain information from the Controller as to whether the Controller processes your personal data and, if so, what data is involved and how it is processed;
- (b) Rectification of personal data, i.e. for the Controller to correct inaccurate personal data without undue delay at your request;
- (c) Erasure of personal data, i.e. the

obligation of the Controller to erase the personal data it processes about you if certain conditions are met and you have requested the Controller to do so;

- (d) Restriction of processing of personal data, i.e. for the Controller to restrict the processing of your personal data in certain cases;
- (e) Portability of personal data, i.e. the ability to obtain the personal data you have provided to the Controller in a common and machine-readable format and the right to request the transfer of that data to another controller or, where technically feasible, to request that the controllers transfer it between themselves;
- (f) Object to the processing of personal data where your personal data is processed on the basis of a legitimate interest;
- (g) Withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data at any time, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing carried out prior to its withdrawal, where the processing is based on consent given to the Controller.

1.8 Right to lodge a complaint:
